Lobbying has a strict legal and IRS definition

- **Direct:** Communications with any legislator, their staff, or government official who participates in formulating legislation that refers to AID expresses a view on specific legislation AND includes a statement that asks for specific action
- **Grassroots:** Communications that ask members of the public to contact their elected legislators to urge support of or opposition to, proposed or pending legislation. AND includes contact information

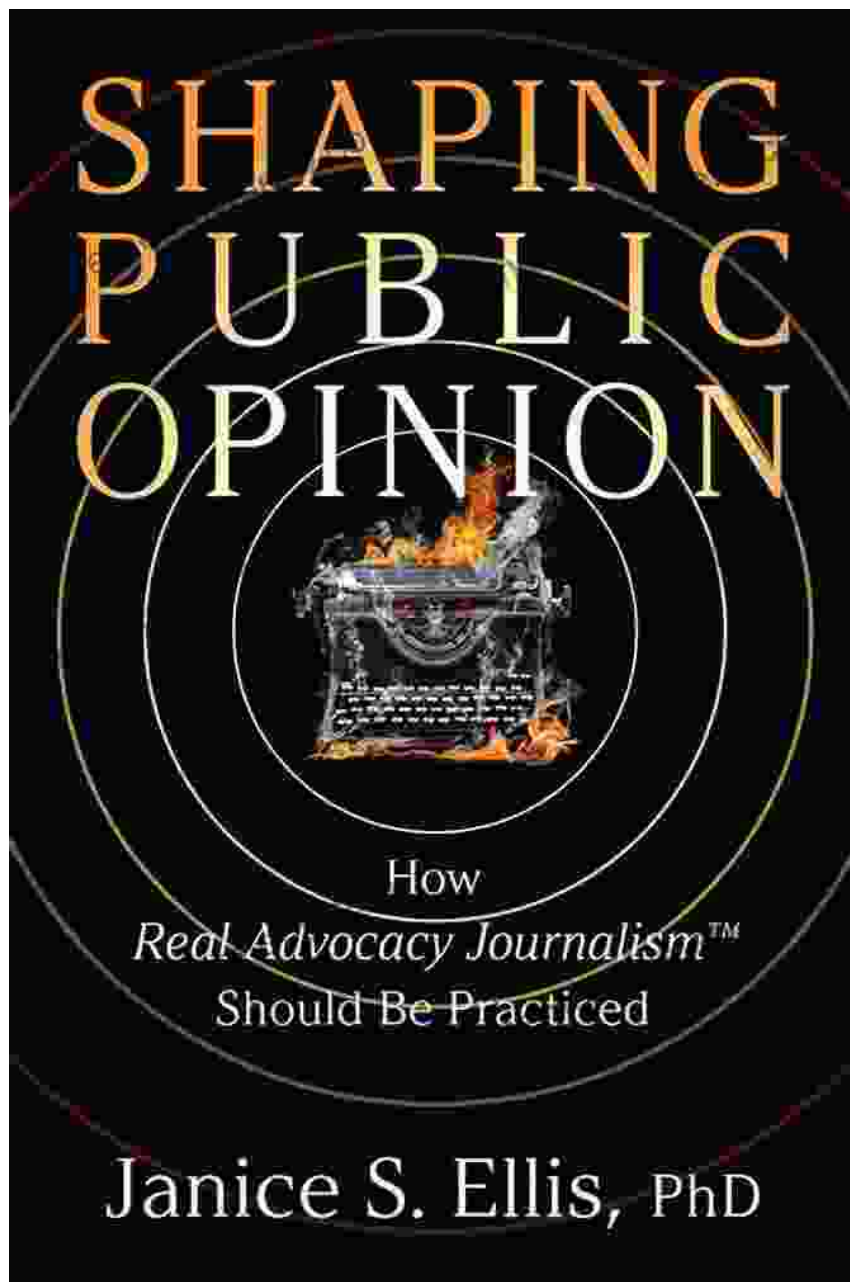
